10% Waiver Policy		•	Petition the Music Education area with an application for exemption that includes a personal narrative of why the student believes they should be given an exemption; Submit a letter of recommendation from a current music faculty member; Students must apply by the first day of the spring semester of their Junior year. Music education faculty will review these materials as well as the student's progress in the program to date and determine whether the student may be counted as part of the 10% waiver. Please note that a waiver for entry into student teaching is not guaranteed. Waivers are issued by cohort and are to transferable to another year's cohort. Teacher candidates who have received a waiver by then change their student teaching cohort or graduation timeline must apply for a new waiver.
