The following instructions were written for Early Childhood Education students who attend the University of Delaware but have lived in Georgia and need to obtain those out-of-state clearances. If you are not a UD student, you will need to contact the state directly for additional help.

Criminal Record Check Services:

- You will need to contact your local police station, and ask them what they would require you to do to get a state background check.
 - o Georgia is not currently requiring background checks, but Delaware does.
 - o Because of this, there is not a process in place to get this done on a state level.
