*The following instructions were written for Early Childhood Education students who attend the University of Delaware but have lived in Georgia and need to obtain those out-of-state clearances. **If you are not a UD student, you will need to contact the state directly for additional help.***

Criminal Record Check Services:

- You will need to contact your local police station, and ask them what they would require you to do to get a state background check.
 - Georgia is not currently requiring background checks, but Delaware does.
 - Because of this, there is not a process in place to get this done on a state level.

- You must submit a [screening form](#) to check for your Child Protective Services history.

 - You do not need to complete the section asking for current household members.
 - Print the form
 - Scan the form to us at clinicalstudies@udel.edu. Georgia does not allow the person making the request to be the same as the person who is being checked. We must submit it for you.
