## **Illinois Instructions**

The following instructions were written for Early Childhood Education students who attend the University of Delaware but have lived in Illinois and need to obtain those out-of-state clearances. If you are not a UD student, you will need to contact the state directly for additional help.

## **Criminal Record Check Services:**

- Complete the Illinois Fingerprint Authorization Form.
- Find a <u>Fingerprinting locations</u> (no appointment needed).
- Take your authorization form and government issued ID (driver's license or valid state identification card number).
- Retain the fingerprint receipt you receive for your records. It will contain the Transaction Control Number (TCN).
- Once you receive the clearance results, forward the results to the Office of Clinical Studies at <u>clinicalstudies@udel.edu</u> or drop off a copy at our office at 200 Academy Street.

## Adam Walsh/Child Protective Service Background Record Request:

- Complete the <u>Illinois Adam Walsh Child Neglect form.</u>
- Fill in your personal information.
- List all previous addresses you have lived in Illinois for the past five years.
- List if you've used any other names
- Print the filled-out form, sign and date it.
- Submit using one of these methods:

- Keep a copy for your records.
